1. AUTHORITY

1.1 This Regulation is enacted pursuant to sections 3.1 and 12.5 of the By-law.

2. DEFINITIONS

2.1 In this Regulation capitalized terms have the same meaning as they do in the By-law.

3. CERTIFICATE OR ID SHALL NOT BE REPRODUCED

3.1 As provided in the By-law, a Certificate of Registration, Certificate of Licensing or photo identification shall not be reproduced in whole or in part without the written consent of the Registrar.

4. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF REGULATION

4.1 A Licensee, Sole Proprietorship or Firm who contravenes section 12.5 of the By-law is guilty of an offence and will be subject to the following penalties:

- a) For a first offence, written warning with direction to remove all certificate and/or identification images within thirty (30) calendar days, and to confirm the same in writing to the Registrar.
- b) For a second or subsequent offence – \$100 per incident.
- c) Failure to remove all certificate and/or identification images within thirty (30) calendar days, and to confirm the same in writing to the Registrar, is subject to suspension and ultimately revocation.
