### 1. AUTHORITY

1.1 This Regulation is enacted pursuant to sections 3.1 and 12.5 of the By-law.

# 2. **DEFINITIONS**

2.1 In this Regulation capitalized terms have the same meaning as they do in the By-law.

### 3. CERTIFICATE OR ID SHALL NOT BE REPRODUCED

3.1 As provided in the By-law, a Certificate of Registration, Certificate of Licensing or photo identification shall not be reproduced in whole or in part without the written consent of the Registrar.

# 4. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF REGULATION

- 4.1 A Licensee, Sole Proprietorship or Firm who contravenes section 12.5 of the By-law is guilty of an offence and will be subject to the following penalties:
  - a) For a first offence, written warning with direction to remove all certificate and/or identification images within thirty (30) calendar days, and to confirm the same in writing to the Registrar.
  - b) For a second or subsequent offence \$100 per incident.
  - c) Failure to remove all certificate and/or identification images within thirty (30) calendar days, and to confirm the same in writing to the Registrar, is subject to suspension and ultimately revocation.
